



Uniform Policy

Principles

It is our policy that all children should wear clothing that is in keeping with a purposeful learning ethos. We also believe it is important that certain activities are facilitated by specialised and appropriate clothing when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours. We provide a complete list of the items needed for children's school uniform in this policy.

Aims

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform promotes a sense of pride in the school engenders a feeling of community and belonging is practical and smart identifies the children with the school is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be) makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents has been designed with health and safety in mind.

Uniform is as follows:

Boys

School sweatshirt with school logo
White polo shirt
School book bag with school logo
School water bottle with school logo
Grey/black trousers or grey/black shorts

Girls

School sweatshirt with school logo
White polo shirt
School book bag with school logo
School water bottle with school logo
Grey/Black skirt, grey trousers or grey dress

For PE all children FS2 – Y6 need:

T-shirt
School gym bag with school logo
A pair of trainers and a tracksuit for 'outdoor' P.E.
Juniors will need trainers and possibly a football kit at the top of the school
Please Note: PE kits should be kept in school all week and full named.

Footwear

Black shoes with flat heel or plain black trainers. If it is a wet or cold day and your child needs to wear wellies or warm boots to travel to school, please make sure they have normal school shoes to change into.



Jewellery

We do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school.

Make up and Cosmetics

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name
