## Doctor, Dentist, data and a reminder

Another busy week at Mount Pleasant School saw the children in KS1 visit the dental centre and the doctors: parents joined EYFS to look at the learning recorded in the Early Years Foundation Stage Profile; the School Governance Committee met in school.

Did you know in the school year 2016-17 at MPS:

- 100% of pupils making a good level of development at the end of the Foundation Stage against 71% of pupils nationally.
- The average point score in EYFS was 43.7 against 34.4 nationally.
- 100% of Year 1 Pupils achieved the expected level in the Phonics Check against 81.3% nationally.
- 80% of Year 2 Pupils achieved the expected level in Reading, Writing and Maths compared to 69% nationally.
- 100% of pupils achieved over 100 in the scaled score for Reading, Writing and Maths against 61% nationally.

A reminder that, we are in production of a new web site: this is a DCYP project with the Army Media Team in the UK. What would you have liked to see on the school web site that would help give you more information prior to your move to Mount Pleasant? The new sites are directed at parents as an information source. On Monday 13th November at 14:30, I will be holding a coffee and web site session and invite you to come along with your ideas. I will also be able to show you the updated web site. Our current web site holds all the statutory information required by Ofsted and is the place we are directing people to until the new site is launched.
