Uniform—an update

Thank you once again, to those who are wearing our smart new uniform. More uniform arrived in the post this week and it is pleasing to see so many pupils wearing it. The new uniform really does look great on, presents a wonderful image of the school and a creates a real sense of respect in our community from the children. In consultation and listening to parental comments we have made a change to the date we are expecting all pupils to be wearing the new uniform. New pupils to school, from now forward, will only be permitted to wear the new uniform, existing pupils will have to the end of this academic year to obtain new uniform.

- FS1—Y6 children must have jumper or cardigan from the new supplier by the end of this academic year. Please do not pass your legacy jumpers to your replacements or the thrift shop as any new pupils entering school from now forward will not be permitted to wear them.
- All jumpers and cardigans must be either from 'Initially Yours' or legacy stock and display the Mount Pleasant Logo. This is inline with the existing uniform policy.
 Jumpers and cardigans not displaying the school logo are not part of school uniform and children will be asked not to wear them from October half term.
- White logo T-Shirts make our uniform as smart as possible and wearing these would support that part of the ethos and values of the school.
- Fleece Jackets are not replacements for jumpers or cardigans but an optional item which is smart and practical for all children to wear outside on the school playground.
- The sun hat should be purchased for children in EYU, FS1 and FS2. Other children are welcome to wear this hat and in the summer months it will provide sun protection.
- We have a PE uniform for children FS2—Y6 which is a school logo t-shirt and school hoodie. Having a PE uniform ensures all children are suitably dressed to take part in the PE activities.
- It is important that you order in good time as items are individually prepared by 'Initially Yours' and then posted to Mount Pleasant.
- This represents no change to our uniform policy which also states children must have school logo book bag and for those in FS2-Y6, a school logo PE bag.
