A busy continuation of the term

This week in Mrs Shazell's class the children have been looking at food and had a visit in the afternoon from Sodexo who helped them decorate cup cakes and biscuits. They looked delicious!

Key Stage One now have a lovely Seal welcoming them to their classroom and have had a week of learning, including getting to grips with money.

Some children in Key Stage two were able to learn a 'magic trick' this week—it was not a magic trick at all but an example of metacognition: the process of learning to learn where they knew the answer (the outcome of the trick) but were challenged to work the process back to be able to perform the trick. This is a very useful way to learn, especially in maths, where we might know the answer but need to better understand how we got to it.

Next week, all the children will be visiting 1435 Flt. They will visit on Monday 4th February between 11:00 and 12:00, they will be taken by bus, accompanied by school staff and will return in time for lunch.
