We continue to work together to ensure that we identify our school improvement priorities and work towards achieving them in a collaborative way.

Safeguarding Update

Safeguarding and keeping children safe is our number one priority in school.

I have taken on the role of **Designated Safeguarding Lead**, with both Ms Summers and Mrs Deane acting as **Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads**. We explain to the children that they can talk to any adult in school about anything that is worrying them, but that myself, Ms Summers and Mrs Deane have the special job of keeping them safe. If, as an adult, you have any concerns about a child, please feel able to talk to one of us too.

As part of our safeguarding commitment, we ensure that we explore the importance of e-safety with children across school. Next week we will be sending home with KS1 / KS2 children 'Acceptable use of the internet, emails and computers' agreements. We would appreciate you talking these through with your child, signing them and returning them to school.

As a staff, we are in the process of updating certain policies, such as our Behaviour Policy. We always ensure that we respond to children's views and, following a discussion with Y1 to Y6 children, I was delighted with their positive view on behaviour in school. We will send this policy out to you for information next week too.
