

School Uniform Policy

September 2020

It is our policy that all children (FS1 to KS2) will wear our uniform each day.

Aims

The aims of our school uniform policy are to:

- help the children identify with the school
- · instill a sense of pride in the school and support positive behaviour
- engender a feeling of community, belonging and common purpose
- · make children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- wear clothes that are both practical, comfortable and smart
- allow a change of clothing for PE and certain other activities to ensure the clothing worn is suited to the activity
- have a uniform that is regarded as both suitable and good value for money

Wider School Aims/Ethos

Our uniform plays a valuable role in encouraging identity with and support for our purposeful learning ethos, thereby helping to support effective teaching and learning.

Daily Uniform - FS2 to Year 6 (and can be worn by FS1) is as follows:

We would ask that you purchase the following item, with the school logo, from the uniform shop:

School jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt

Children will also need the following, which can be purchased from any outlet:

- Grey trousers / skirts or dresses
- White polo shirts
- Sturdy school shoes
- Weatherproof rucksack / bag
- Water bottle
- A book bag

PE Kit - FS2 to Y6

Children will need the following, which can be purchased from any outlet:

- Burgundy t-shirt
- Burgundy hoody
- · Blue or black shorts
- · Blue or black jogging bottoms
- Trainers or plimsolls

Swimming Kit - FS2 to Y6

Children will need the following, which can be purchased from any outlet:

- One-piece swimsuit / swimming trunks (not shorts)
- Swim cap (for long hair)
- Towel
- Goggles

You can purchase our logo school jumper/cardigan/sweatshirt from http://www.initiallyyours.co.uk who will deliver directly to school.

The uniform shop also sells the following items with the school logo should you wish to purchase:

- School fleece jacket
- White polo shirt
- School hoody
- School PE t-shirt / shorts
- School book bag / School PE bag
- School Baseball cap / School Hi Viz

Please Note: all items should be labelled with you're the child's name and PE kits should be kept in school all week.

Footwear

If it is a wet or cold day and your child needs to wear wellies or warm boots to travel to school, please make sure they have appropriate school shoes to change into.

Walking to school

Most children walk to school and we would recommend wearing a high visibility tabard or similar reflective outer clothing.

Jewellery

We do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school.

Make up and Cosmetics

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children.

If for any reason your child/ren should need to wear any other items of clothing please contact the school.
