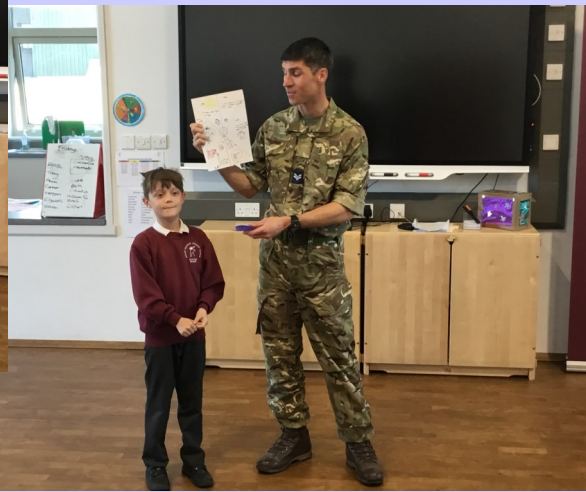
Teaching the children in KS2 the Green Cross Code and the stopping distances of vehicles.
