Last week we had our 'Safeguarding' visit from Kareen Brand the Senior Social Worker for BFSWS. Kareen asked 7 members of staff multiple questions to check their knowledge and understanding of the recent 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' Govt. document and garnered evidence that the process we have in school to identify, discuss with the appropriate staff, record and maintain confidentiality are of an excellent standard. Kareen was pleased that children were happy and attentive as well as friendly and polite.
