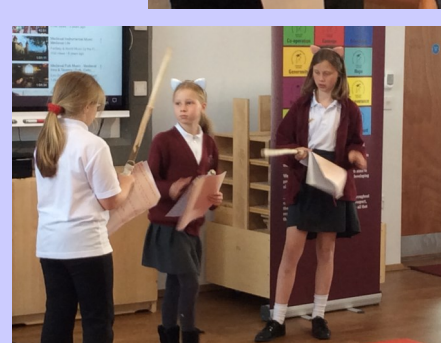
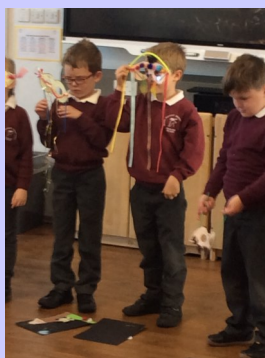
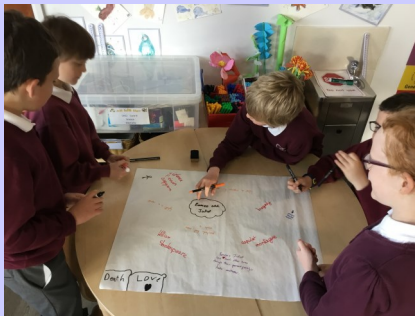
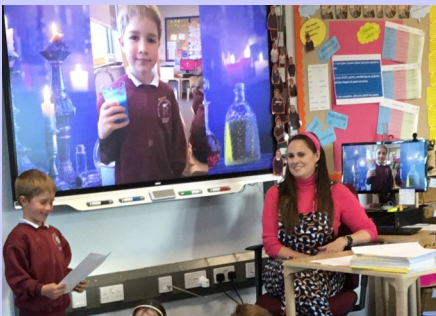
We were also delighted to be joined for this musical event followed by a tour of the school by:

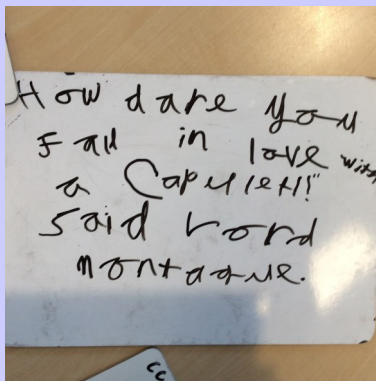
Romeo and Juliet
