Welcome back to a very busy last half term with lots going on particularly with regards to transition, as we help prepare children for new classes, schools and countries.

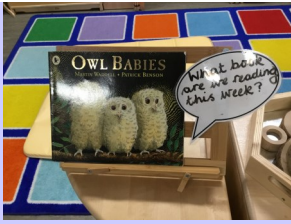

In EYFS: This week in EYFS our focus text has been 'Owl Babies'. We have listened to the story every day.

Nursery have been using the indoor and outdoor area and have been making feathers move.

FS1 have been making feathers move by blowing them with straws, creating owl pictures, making nests out of natural objects and are starting to write their names.



FS2 have been using role play to retell the story, writing about the story, using different shades of brown paint and feathers to create owls and describing owls. In PE the children have been balancing on different pieces of equipment. In maths the children have been using numbers up to one hundred and

using 2d shapes to make shape pictures.

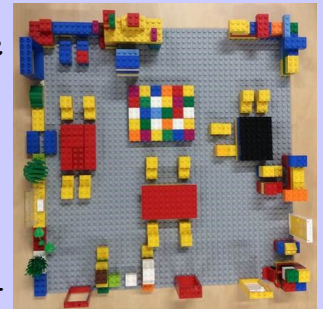


In Caracara Class: In Caracara Class this week, the children have been making predictions, Year 2s have been focusing on the use of an

apostrophe for possession and everyone has been writing descriptive noun phrases to support their writing for next week. In Maths, we've been busy learning about position, direction and move-

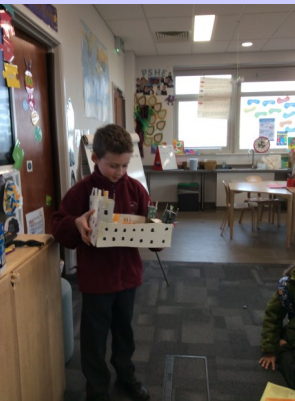
ment. Some of us still need to know left and right convincingly! We had a great time in geography look-

ing at a plan of the classroom, talking about aerial or bird's eye views and creating the classroom plan using Lego. You can see that the children have thought carefully about the positioning of the doors and furniture.



In Falcon Class: Falcon's Class have had a lovely week, looking at all of the wonderful topic homework they have created. We have had a range of items from models of Hever Castle and the Tower of London in Lego and cardboard, (some even had working portcullis and drawbridges), to designs of outfits for Tudor Kings and

Queens. The children have continued learning about time, using position and direction to help them and in Art, they are putting the finishing touches to their designs before adding the illumination. In English, the children have been looking at the features of a setting description so that they can create one of their own later in the term.
