Dear Parents

The children have really enjoyed the snow and the opportunity to build igloo's, snowmen and snow sculptures at every playtime. It has been great that the children have been prepared with the right winter clothing and have persevered with their designs over a number of days. It has been a wonderful and wintery way to reach mid winter/Fixmas.

In EYFS: This week in EYFS we have been reading the book 'Whatever Next!'

FS1 & 2 have been thinking about and recording using words and pictures what they would take to the moon with them if they went on an adventure like the bear in the story. They have been using boxes to create rockets, spaceships and sofas. The children have used the role play areas to plan and recreate scenes from the story and from their own imagination.



We have all thoroughly enjoyed playing, digging and building in the snow throughout the week.







In Caracara Class: Caracara Class have been continuing the story of 'Tadpole's Promise'. We have written setting descriptions focusing on precise choice of words, thought bubbles to show what the characters might have been thinking at different times during the text and written a storyboard using the language from the text. As you can see we've been very busy in English! In maths our work continues with money and we've progressed to working out change. In art, we discussed how detail would not be a good choice when designing our work for wet felting next week. We're very excited about turning our designs into a felted product next week.

In Falcon Class: . This week Falcons have begun their geography topic 'settlements'. They have looked at a variety of ancient settlements and looked at sites to see if they would be suitable for a settlement based on survival criteria. They have also been involved in a historical debate about which monarch was the best overall, Queen Elizabeth I or King Henry VIII. The children surprised me with their debating skills and many have very firm views about which they preferred and why! In Science, they have started learning about sound and what causes it by making their own cup telephones using string and investigating whether the sound carries better when it is taut or loose. Some children have also used their electrical and sound knowledge to build circuits and send Morse code messages to
