Plover Class:

In maths we have been counting, creating number sentences and weighing toy superheroes.

In literacy we have been reading the book 'My Mum is a Supermum'. We have been writing labels, descriptions and powers for superheroes.

In creative areas we have been acting like superheroes, creating potions to give us powers and making superhero masks.

In physical we have been using our superhero powers to move in different ways both inside and outside.

They have also been on a classroom expedition, working with a partner to go on an Egyptian fact hunt and return to field base to report their findings. This tested their communication and memory skills and helped them build a file of facts to help them with their English mystery story later in the term.
